It was with great sadness that I learned of the death of Sister Jane Marie Lamb, OSF. For those of you who did not Sister, she was a wonderful, gentle, and peaceful woman who was a pioneer in Perinatal bereavement. Sister Jane Marie founded SHARE in 1997 in Springfield IL and was the author/editor of Bittersweet Hello Goodbye book that is used by many parents and churches to plan infant funerals.

I will never forget the first time I met Sister. It was at a conference in St. Louis. We were standing in front of an infant memorial quilt display when she began to talk to me. Surprisingly, she knew who I was even though we had never been introduced. She told me that she had been to the IRIS display table and began to ask me about the quilts we had on display and clothing that we had designed. She was curious about where we got the fabric, why we chose that type of fabric, and asked who did the sewing for us. After about a half hour of conversation with myself and other IRIS volunteers she said she was very impressed and would pray for IRIS and us. She left all of us totally speechless. I am pleased to say that later that day I was privileged to be included in pictures with Sister Jane Marie and Cathi Lammert – current Executive Director of Share in front of that very same guilt display.

Candy has spent countless hours working with members of the Minnesota House and Senate for the passage of a bill allowing parents of stillborn children to receive birth certificates. Her hard work paid off and in May the bill was passed.

Please check the IRIS website <u>www.irisremembers.com</u> for more information on obtaining a birth certificate for a child that has been stillborn. The bill requires those responsible for filing a fetal death report to advise parents that they could request a record of birth, inform them the record is optional and explain how to obtain a record.

Please remember that if you would like one of the forms that is currently being issued, please apply for it in the county where you delivered today.
