Caring for your Pewter Ornament

Every time you use your pewter ornament, hand wash it with mild soap and towel dry thoroughly. Do not put in the dishwasher.

It is recommended to clean the ornament once a year with pewter cleaner. After cleaning apply dry cornstarch with a soft cloth or sponge. Rub the cornstarch all over the ornament and dust off with a soft cloth.

If you get scratches on your ornament, you can blend them into the patina by rubbing the scratch with a very fine steel wool, or a pre-softened "ScotchBrite" pad.
