The "I Knew You In The Womb" sculpture by Timothy P. Schmalz is a commanding bronze statue that will be installed at the Infants Remembered In Silence, Inc. © (IRIS) Office in the spring of 2017.

An angel weeping over an empty cradle is a powerful image and a touching memorial for any children that have been lost. This solid resin-stone cast is coated in a realistic bronze finish and is mounted on a solid matt black base. Timothy personally sculpts every original small masterpiece complete with his signature or monogram. Each replica is detailed by hand to the exacting standards of this modern day master sculptor. Each miniature replica is 7.75" H x 4.5" W X 8" D, weighs approx 5 pounds 8oz and can be personalized with your child's name, date, etc.
